



Anything Cage Assembly Instructions

WARNING

Installing this Salsa product on a bicycle requires in-depth knowledge of bicycle mechanics and professional-grade tools. If you do not have the proper tools or knowledge to perform this installation, please take your bicycle to your local bicycle dealer. Failure to appropriately install this product may lead to component failure, resulting in serious injury or death. We recommend that you have this product installed, adjusted and maintained by a professional bicycle mechanic.

Tools: 4mm hex wrench, torque wrench

Anything Cage Installation

The Anything Cage mounts to standard water bottle cage bosses with M5 bolts. However, it's designed with three bolt holes for use with Fargo, Mukluk and Enabler forks featuring our three-bolt bosses.

WARNING: The Anything Cage will mount to your bicycle in several different ways. Where you position the cage will depend on personal preference, frame size and geometry, as well as the gear you choose to use. Make sure that neither the Anything Cage nor your gear interferes with the function of your bicycle BEFORE attempting to ride.

Three-Bolt Configuration (for Salsa Forks)

1. Mount the cage to the fork using three M5 bolts (fig. 1).
Torque 3–5 Nm
2. Route the straps through the top and bottom slots (fig. 2–3)
3. Place your gear in the cage and strap it down (fig. 4) Check that your cargo and all loose straps are secure before riding and periodically during use.

Standard Water Bottle Cage Mounts

1. Mount the cage to the fork using either the two top or bottom holes (fig. 5). Torque bolts 3–5 Nm
2. Route the straps through the top and bottom slots (see fig. 2–3)
3. Place your gear in the cage and strap it down (fig. 6). Check that your cargo and all loose straps are secure before riding and periodically during use.

Anything Cage Assembly Instructions cont'd

Hose Clamp Mounting

We designed the Anything Cage with slots to accommodate hose clamps for mounting to frames or forks without the necessary braze-ons. Hose clamps should be used only as a last resort.

WARNING: Hose clamps are designed to generate a large amount of clamping force: use at your own risk. Salsa is not responsible for bodily injury or damage to your frame or fork as a result of installing hose clamps.

- Do not use hose clamps on carbon fiber frames or forks
- Do not use hose clamps on thin-walled aluminum frames or forks
- Use of hose clamps may void the frame or fork warranty. Check with the manufacturer

To install:

1. Wrap the clamping area with a rubber shim to avoid scratching your frame
2. Route the clamp through the slots in the Anything Cage and around the frame/fork tube
3. Snug the clamp with a screwdriver

WARNING

- Do not modify the Anything Cage. Doing so will void the warranty (see below)
- Make sure your load is secure before riding (i.e. no loose straps to get caught in the wheels)
- Weight limit: 4 lb

Warranty
