



## Salsa Relish™ Air Shock

The Relish is a low pressure air shock with a total range of 10-80 PSI. A starting point when setting air pressure is to divide rider weight by 4 to 6. Please see the chart below.

As with any shock, recommendations are just starting points. It will always take a few rides to figure out if you need more or less air pressure for your individual riding style. The goal is to have the suspension bottom out two to three times per ride (assuming the ride is at the normal level of aggressiveness of the rider). This ensures you are maximizing the suspension travel that the bike offers. If you never bottom out your suspension, you are lugging around a bunch of travel that is doing you no good, and you're not getting the most out of your bike.

Items such as bottom bracket shells, etc. are covered by the original manufacturer and must be warranted through the appropriate company.

- Damage due to improper assembly or follow-up maintenance or lack of skill, competence or experience of the assembler, mechanic, or user
- Products that have been modified, neglected, used in competition or for commercial purposes, misused or abused, involved in accidents or anything other than normal use
- Damage or deterioration to the surface finish, aesthetics or appearance of the product
- Normal wear and tear
- Labor required to remove and/or refit and re-adjust the product within the bicycle assembly
- Damage to, or caused by, other manufacturers' parts or components included with or attached to Salsa Cycles scandium or steel frames
